**ORDER**

After being advised and carefully considering the Unopposed Motion Regarding Class Notice (“Motion”), exhibits, and the record, the Court GRANTS the Motion and orders:

1. The Court approves the mail notice and long-form notice attached as Exhibits B and C to the Motion. The parties may make any non-material, mutually agreeable changes to the notices.
2. The Court appoints American Legal Claim Services, LLC (“ALCS”) as the class administrator.
3. Notice to the certified class, as defined in the Court’s Order dated January 29, 2025, or to any class definition modified by the Court before mailing of notice, shall be given according to the Notice Plan attached as Exhibit A to the Motion.
4. The Notice Plan includes individual, direct mailed notice to all Class Members who can be identified with reasonable effort. With the address updating protocols that will be employed, it is expected individual notice will be delivered to at least 70% of the Class Members. The case website and toll-free number will expand the reach of the notice further.

5. The Notice Plan provides for the best notice practicable under the circumstances of this case, conforms to all applicable requirements of the Missouri Rules of Civil Procedure and any other applicable law, and is consistent with practices endorsed by the Federal Judicial Center.

6. The Notice Plan schedule affords sufficient time to provide full and proper notice to Class Members before the exclusion deadline.

7. The class members have 60 days after the class administrator first mails notice to exclude themselves under the procedures in the individual notice.
