Judgment

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. This Judgment incorporates this Court's Final Class Action Approval Order entered on the same date as this Judgment.

2. The settlement of the Class's claims on the terms in the parties' Class Action Settlement Agreement and Release executed on November 7, 2022 and filed with this Court on November 7, 2022 as Exhibit 1 to the Joint Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Settlement (the "Agreement") is approved. The Class is granted final certification under Missouri Rule of Civil Procedure 52.08.

3. Individual notice complying with Missouri Rule of Civil Procedure 52.08 was sent to the last-known address of each member of the Class. The Court finds that Class Members are bound by this Judgment.

4. Class Representative and all Class Members who did not timely exclude themselves from the Classes shall be and are bound by the Releases provided in Paragraph 5 of the Agreement.

5. The Court approves CSAC's assignment of claims against CSAC's insurers other than Federated Mutual Insurance Company or Auto Owners, Inc, including without limitation, any

claims of bad faith failure to settle and breach of the duty to defend, to the Settlement Class.

6. This Judgment is final for all purposes except for the determinations and assessments necessary to resolve any additional judgment against CSAC to be determined by the Court at a later date and potentially satisfied by Union's insurance coverage (if any). The Court will retain continuing jurisdiction over this case for the purposes set forth in Paragraphs 7 and 17 of the Final Class Action Approval Order. This Judgment resolves a distinct judicial unit between the parties and is final for purposes of appeal for which there shall be no just reason for delay.

7. Unless otherwise provided, all capitalized terms in this Judgment shall have the same meaning as those terms in the Agreement and Final Approval Order.

8. The Court expressly determines there is no just reason for delay under Missouri Rule of Civil Procedure 74.01.
