2. Attend a hearing at **10:00 A.M. (Eastern Standard Time) on a date no later than February 7, 2020** at the United States District Court Eastern District of Virginia, 401 Courthouse Square, Alexandria, Virginia 22314. **If you or your attorney do not attend the hearing, the Court may grant the relief requested in the Consent Motion.**

If you or your attorney do not take these steps, the Court may deem any opposition waived, treat the Motion as conceded, and issue an order granting the requested relief without further notice or hearing.
