**NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY**

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Friday, March 1, 2024:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Joan B. Gottschall: Plaintiff represents in his amended motion for preliminary approval that copies of all settlement-related papers will be posted on a website for the proposed settlement. ECF No. 43 at 9. This includes the petition for attorneys' fees, expenses, and incentive award ("fee petition") due 3/15/2024, which is also the deadline to send notice to the class. Although the proposed notice informs class members about the website, it states only that the proposed settlement will be available on it; the notice does not indicate when the fee petition will be filed or how a class member can obtain a copy. In *Redman v. RadioShack Corp.*, 768 F.3d 622, 63738 (7th Cir. 2014), the Seventh Circuit held that class members must receive a meaningful opportunity to review the basis for a motion for attorneys' fees and costs (disclosing the amount that will be requested in the class notice does not satisfy this requirement) before the expiration of the deadline to object or opt out. See also *In re TikTok, Inc., Consumer Privacy Litig.*, 617 F. Supp. 3d 904, 93637 (N.D. Ill. 2022), appeal dismissed sub nom. *In re Tiktok Inc., Consumer Privacy Litig.*, No. 22-2682, 2022 WL 19079999 (7th Cir. Oct. 12, 2022). To comply with *Redman*, the notice sent to class members in this case must make clear that all settlement-related filings, including the fee petition, will be posted on the settlement website. The notice must also tell class members that the fee petition, together with all supporting documents, will be posted on the settlement website by a date certain, which must be no later than 3/22/2024. Consistent with this order, a revised proposed form of notice to the class is due on or before 3/5/2024. As a potential starting point for modifying the notice, the attention of counsel is directed to page nine of the amended motion [43] for preliminary approval, specifically the description of the settlement website.
