**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER’S MOTION TO (I) APPROVE
FINAL FEE APPLICATIONS, (II) APPROVE FINAL
DISTRIBUTIONS; AND (III) DETERMINE CRIMINAL RESTITUTION**

Upon the Motion To (i) Approve Final Fee Applications, (ii) Approve Final Distributions, and (iii) Determine Criminal Restitution, (the “Motion”) of Christopher L. Perkins, the Court-appointed Receiver and Special Master (the “Receiver”) in the above-captioned case; and it appearing that notice of the Motion was provided to all Investor Victims, Creditors, and other Parties-in-Interest; and the Court having reviewed the Motion and determined that the grounds

set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY FOUND AND DETERMINED:

- A. The Receiver has given proper and sufficient notice of the Motion;
- B. The Motion is **GRANTED** in its entirety.
- C. All objections are hereby **OVERRULED**.
- D. The Final Fee Applications and Holdback payments are **APPROVED** and the Receiver is authorized and directed to pay the amounts requested.
- E. The Final Distribution is **AUTHORIZED**. After satisfaction in full of the Administrative Claims, taxes, and other expenses of the Receivership Estates, each Holder of an Allowed Class 2 Claim shall receive its pro rata share of the funds in Pool 2 from the Cash Available.
- F. The Receiver is **AUTHORIZED** to establish the Reserve in the amount of \$18,000 to wind-down and close the Receivership. Any surplus Reserve remaining after payment of outstanding fees and expenses shall be applied towards the Criminal Restitution established by separate Order of this Court.
- G. The Court retains jurisdiction over any and all matters related to the Receiver and the Receivership estates.
